Corbin to assist me at \$50 per month and board, and he be required to work one gang of men; also that I be given one day guard at \$25 per month and board and one night guard at \$25 per month and board. I think the best results can be gotten out of the convicts if I have charge of the guards and convicts and be responsible to you for the work of the guards and convicts.
