After some discussion and upon motion of Mr. Newman, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, the Committee unanimously voted to recommend that some type of permanent marker be established on Cemetery Hill to indicate this colored graveyard.

The meeting was adjourned upon motion of Mr. Rhodes.
