

MINUTES OF THE BUILDINGS & GROUNDS COMMITTEE MEETING HELD MAY 16, 1946

The Buildings and Grounds Committee met at 12 noon on May 16 in the classroom of the Filter Plant. Members present were Messrs. Holmes, Hunter, Lee, Musser, Newman, Rhodes, and Watson.

This meeting was called for further discussion and action on the report submitted by the sub-committee at the meeting held May 14 covering names for streets and buildings. It was moved by Mr. Holmes and seconded by Mr. Lee (both members of the sub-committee) that the following names be deleted from the list submitted by the sub-committee:

- Strode, Craighead, and Mell (all presidents)
- Wannamaker, Bowen, and Bradley (all trustees)

The motion was carried.

Upon motion by Mr. Lee, seconded by Mr. Musser, the Committee voted to recommend adoption of the following names for buildings:

Barracks #1	Simpson Hall
Barracks #2	Johnstone Hall
Physics Building	Norris Hall
Library Building	Sikes Library
Proposed new Plant Science Building	Newman Hall
Proposed new Chemistry Building	Hardin Hall
Proposed new Extension Building	Lever Hall
Proposed new Agricultural or Engineering Building	Manning Hall

There are other barracks buildings yet to be named which the Committee desires to make further study of.

Upon motion by Mr. Hunter, seconded by Mr. Musser, the Committee voted to recommend adoption of the following names for campus streets and roads:

1. The new street parallel with the Pendleton Highway, at the rear of the residences occupied by Messrs. Woodward, Ritchie, Eaton, Cloaninger, and Goodale, which enters the Pendleton highway immediately east of the Goodale residence and the South Palmetto Boulevard at the rear of the Woodward residence .....Morrison Road
2. The new street at the rear of the Sheep Barn, which enters South Palmetto Boulevard just east of the S. B. Earle residence and immediately in front of the C. S. Patrick residence.....Colonial Circle
3. The new road which enters the Cherry Road in front of the Dairy Laboratory in the rear of the present Veterinary Hospital and the service road near the H. C. Goodman residence.....Jersey Lane

There are other streets to be named, and it has been suggested that the several groups of veterans' houses be given a place name rather than numbered by areas or groups. The committee will act on these matters later.
