Excepting only college students, who will be deferred until July 1. members of the land or naval forces, certain government officials, aliens who have not applied for citizenship, clergymen, diviniy students, conscientious objectors, and habitual criminals, there will be no blanket exemptions of entire occupations and industries such as the shipyards classification which caused a scandal in 1917.
