

MINUTES OF THE BUILDINGS & GROUNDS COMMITTEE MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 16, 1946

Members present were Messrs. Hunter, Holmes, Lee, Musser, Rhodes, Newman, and Watson. This was a follow-up meeting to that held on September 9 and was for the purpose of recommending names for the several groups of veterans' housing units and for streets within the different areas. Recommendations given below were adopted by the Committee.

It was recommended that the area bounded on the north by the Seneca highway, on the west by the Seneca River, on the east by Williamson Road, and on the south by the branch, be named Goodman Place. This was selected because Mr. John Samuel Goodman was for a long time the only occupant of this area. He worked for the College during the construction of Main Building and for many years afterward, and two of his sons spent practically all their lives working for the College also.

It was recommended that the area adjacent to the Horticulture Grounds, bounded on the east by Cherry Road, on the south by the Dairy pasture fence, on the west by the branch which runs into Hunnicutt Creek, and on the north by Oak Lane and the Horticulture Grounds be named DuPre Place. This name was selected to honor the memory of Mr. J. C. (or J. P.) DuPre, who was the first professor of horticulture at Clemson and who did much toward laying out the present horticulture grounds.

It was recommended that the area immediately back of Dr. S. B. Earle's residence (College residence #105) on the Cherry Road, which area includes the duplex housing units on both sides of the Cherry Road and on the court near the Henderson residence (College residence #120), be called Sloan Place.

It was recommended that the area around the old Sheep Barn in the vicinity of Hanover House be called Hanover Place.

Street names within the different areas were recommended as follows:

Goodman Place (Berkshire Road: the main road through the middle of the area.  
Place (Ravenel Road: street next to woods nearest highway.  
(Sunset Road: street parallel with Berkshire Road and south of it.  
(It was recommended that cross streets be called by letters.

DuPre Place (Milky Way: the middle street of the area.  
Place (Woodridge: street along Dairy pasture.  
(Sawney Street: street along branch  
(Hillside: street at right angle to Dairy land.  
(Pecan Street: short street at right angle to Cherry Road.
